Welcome Race Fans to Five Star Liquor Stratford Speedway for tonight's massive event that has been sponsored by the awesome team at Dicksons Service Centre. Dicksons service and repair all makes and models of cars and light commercial vehicles so they can get you sorted no matter what you drive.

Tonight's feature events are the Repco Youth Ministock Spectacular, Demolition Derby Teams Racing and the King of the Mountain Stockcar Champs. The Youth Ministocks may not be the fastest cars on the track but these drivers have skills to match the best in the big classes. Watch their racing lines, race craft and ability and you will soon see why competitors from this class quickly succeed when they move onto the bigger classes. Tonight, the girls will run in one group over three heats and the boys will run I none group, utilising the ³/₄ format - there will be four races but each competitor will only race in three. Top points in each group wins.

The Demolition Derby Teams Racing will take place with qualifying rounds and then the finals which should culminate in some carnage filled racing. The drivers will need to look after their cars in the early rounds but once they reach either the race for third and fourth or first and second they don't need to save them for anything else so can put in all on the line. Qualifying races will be for points - 1st 100, 2nd 40, 3rd 25, 4th 20, 5th 10 with the highest two points scoring teams racing in the final and the lowest scoring racing for third and fourth. The final races will be first across the line so the winner of the race wins for their team.

A near full field of Stockcars will be on hand to contest the King of the Mountain Champs while Superstocks and Vintage Sprintcars will complete the program.

SPEEDWAY 101

SO YOU HAVE NEVER BEEN TO SPEEDWAY BEFORE,

well, you're in for a treat tonight. Stratford Speedway has been around for over fifty years with racing starting on this site way back in 1964. A variety of classes have raced throughout that time, some no longer exist while some have evolved into what you will see on the track tonight.

These days, nine different classes race at Stratford Speedway, with up to six of these racing on any given night. From time to time, other invitational classes will make an appearance while other feature events are held throughout the season including among other things, Demolition Derbies and Stockcar Soccer.

THE RACES:

The most common duration for race length is ten laps. Superstocks, Stockcars, Streetstocks and the Adult Ministocks all begin their race form a standing start at the start line which is in front of the grandstand. All the other classes – Modifieds, Midgets, Saloons, Minisprints and Youth Ministocks will start from a rolling start. The field will follow the pace ute around the track until it pulls off at turn two at which point the drivers know they are about to start. The lights will go green and the race starts coming off turn four.

The races may be stopped or slowed at any time due to crashes or incidents. Most classes will stop when the officials activate the red lights however the Modifieds, Midgets, Minisprints and Saloons don't run the red light and will slow when the yellow comes on. Competitors will circulate slowly until the race is restarted which will be done in a single file format.

RACE RADIOS:

All classes run these. Officials will communicate with drivers via the radios to advise them of impending red or yellow lights, to move to correct grid positions and so on. The radios are one way only and the competitors can't talk back to the officials.







SUPERSTOCKS **T///// Repco**

Without doubt this is the premier contact class in New Zealand Speedway. The cars are fast, expensive, and heavy (weighing in at between 1400 and 1500 kg's). Drivers are not only permitted to, but encouraged to hit each other (in their cars of course). The cars run a variety of engines but Nissan and Toyota V8's are the most popular at this point in time.

STOCKCARS

Looking just like the Superstocks, these cars have more restrictive rules in place to keep the cost down. The cars are still quick, still heavy and the drivers still like to hit each other, in fact more so than the Superstocks due to the lesser amount of money involved. Engines popular in this class include 6 cylinder Ford and Holden's, although almost every manufacturer can be found somewhere in the class.





MODIFIEDS

FABRICATION

Wild things with big wings! Modifieds are a spectacular class. The cars run big tyres, big wings and big Methanol breathing engines that produce well over 600 horsepower. The wings on the cars help them to corner extremely efficiently and this makes for very fast and spectacular racing.

MOUNTAIN SALOO

One of the few classes that on appearance resemble a road going car. However, closer inspection will reveal anything but. The cars run space framed pipe chassis, run mostly V8 engines running on Avgas and produce somewhere around the 500 horsepower mark.





SUPER SALOONS

At first glance, they may resemble a saloon, but unlike a traditional saloon, these vehicles run on methanol and feature adjustable suspension, larger rear tyres, and more powerful engines. They also boast a distinctive body shape, enhanced by the addition of a plastic wedge front clip nose cone that adds to their unique style.

THE CLASSES



STREETSTOCKS CONTRACTOR

A budget racing class that is effectively road going cars altered into racing machines by removing windows, door cards, seats etc and installing a roll cage along with a few race parts. Holden commodores and Ford Falcons are particularly popular in this class. Light contact (tap and spin) is permitted.



YOUTH MINISTOCKS

TOOL HIE

A class for kids between the ages of twelve and sixteen to race in. The cars are similar in appearance to Superstocks and Stockcars but only run 1200cc Datsun and Toyota engines. Cars are built almost identically and run to strict racing rules with no contact permitted. The young drivers learn valuable car control skills before they even get their road license.





ADULT MINISTOCKS

Identical cars and rules to the Youth Ministocks but with no age restrictions. Good for new drivers on a budget to get out on the track and learn race craft.



Similar in appearance and size to the Midgets but running smaller engines and front and top wings. Although they have less power, the wings help the cars to corner and ensures that their lap times are on a par with the Midgets.

UHLENBURG NABS SECOND NATIONAL TITLE

Stratford Minisprint competitor Karl Uhlenberg dominated the field to win the Central Quarries & Crushing New Zealand Minisprint Grand Prix at Stratford Speedway on Saturday March 1st, his second title win in five weeks after he also won the New Zealand Championship in Palmerston North on January 25 th . After breezing through the qualifying races with a first place form grid four and third place from grid eleven and scoring the highest points of all the twenty two competitors, Uhlenberg started the twenty five lap final from grid one, grabbed the lead at the race start and stayed there until completion, carving his way through the back markers and unable to be challenged for the top spot on the podium.

The racing for the Minisprint class resulted in a great outcome for the local drivers with Cody Ogle taking second place and Regan Ogle third. Cody Ogle was lucky to survive a half spin of his own doing early in the race without losing too much ground and was able to reign in Cameron Hurley who had made a pass for third place during Ogle's mishap and then went one better on a late race restart to pass his brother Regan. Stratford competitors filled the first five spots in the champion-ship with Hurley fourth behind Ogle and Duane Hickman fifth.

Liam Whelan, who was racing for the first time since an injury last season brought more success for Taranaki competitors when he won the Under 23 Stockcar Champs by a one point margin over Palmerston North driver Josh Mulcahy. Current New Zealand Stockcar Champion Caleb Ireland from Hawkes Bay was third. Thirty eight cars raced in the event with drivers travelling from as far North as Auckland and as far South as Dunedin, with most tracks in between represented.

The Saloon class raced for their Mountain Motors Taranaki Champs and after wining the first two races, Bradley Korff looked to be the man to beat and eventually was but things did look a little dire for him in race three when he got a little greedy and rather than settling for second place in the race behind Craig Korff and guaranteeing the win overall, he attempted an outside pass, clipped the wall and dropped back to fourth. He still managed to win the event by the smallest of margins - one point. Craig Korff was second and Palmerston North driver Jonathan Mason third.

Streetstocks raced for their Holdin Heaven Taranaki Champs also with nine local competitors joined by Corry Terito from Auckland and Jason Dunn who races out of Whanganui. Dylan Smith was the clear winner after finishing second in race one and then winning the next two. Things were a little closer behind him with Jared Pryce and Dunn being tied on points for second and third. A four lap run off was utilized to determine the finishing order with Pryce unable to stop Dunn who took second place, Pryce third.


